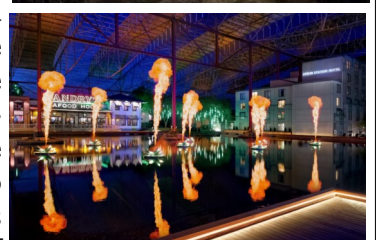
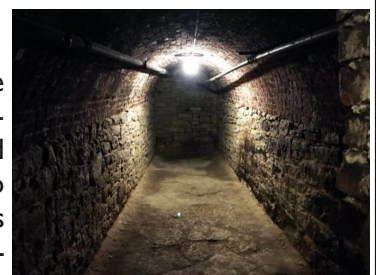
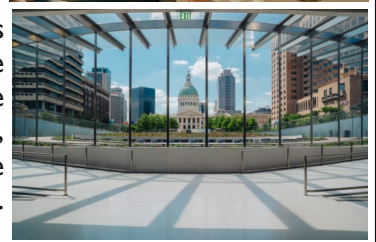
Everything old is new again in St. Louis. Join Vista Club as we experience what's new in St. Louis, MO on this fun-filled overnight trip.

Take a leisurely stroll around this historic location, relax while enjoying some ice cream at the Soda Fountain, dine at one of the amazing on-site restaurants (a list will be provided), or take in one of the evening shows including the Fire and Light Show and the Grand Hall Light Show. DAY 2

Following our included breakfast at the hotel, we will take a short drive to the Gateway Arch National Park. Experience the beginnings of St. Louis and how people travelled here creating the Gateway to the Mississippi in a newly, re-designed format. This renovated park continues to offer Ride-on-the-Tram (if you want to go to the top of the arch), a new movie which provides a great overview of the Gateway Arch experience, and six new incredible interactive galleries. The best part is you get to decide which activities you want to experience while at the park. (Note: activities chosen determine final trip fee.) Next, we begin our travel back to Illinois along the mighty Mississippi River to the town of Alton for included lunch at the delectable Brown Bag Bistro. After lunch, our step-on guide will join us for a rare and unique look at The Underground Railroad sites featured in the area along with stories from this area which changed America. Our 2-day adventure comes to a close as we begin the journey home offering a break in Litchfield before we drop off the travelers. Don't miss out on this amazing experience in St. Louis and leave the driving to us!
