YOUR ITINERARY

DAY 1 Flight to Newark, NJ. Scenic drive to Albany, New York. Arrive at the Hampton Inn Albany, for one night. Dinner in Albany. (D)

DAY 2 Breakfast. Guided tour of Albany driving by the NY State Capitol Building en route to Saratoga Springs. Guided tour of Saratoga Springs — an historic Victorian city known for its natural mineral springs & spas, American Revolutionary monuments, battlefields, and thoroughbred horse racing. View fall foliage on a scenic drive to the summit of Whiteface Mountain. Arrive at the High Peaks Resort for a two night stay in the charming mountain village of Lake Placid, NY. Dinner at the hotel. 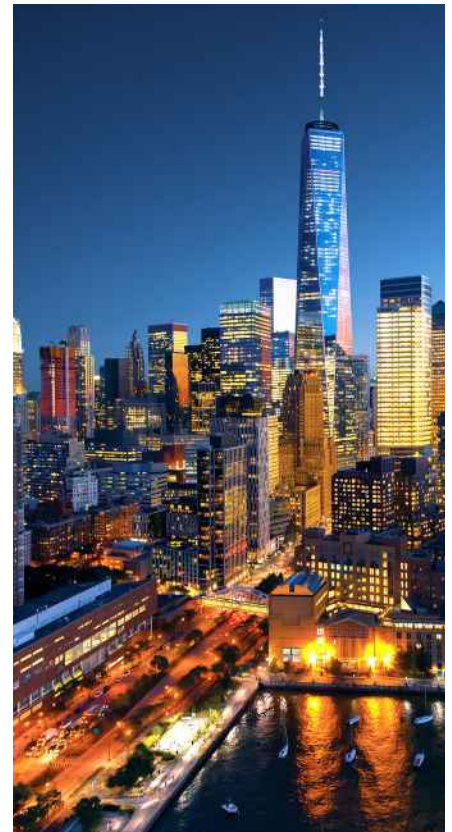
