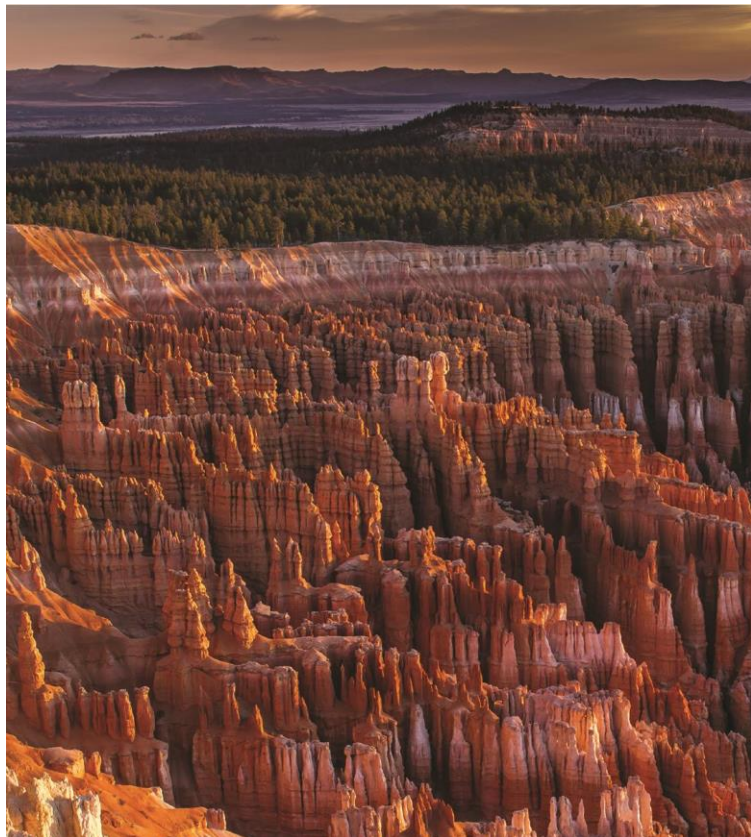
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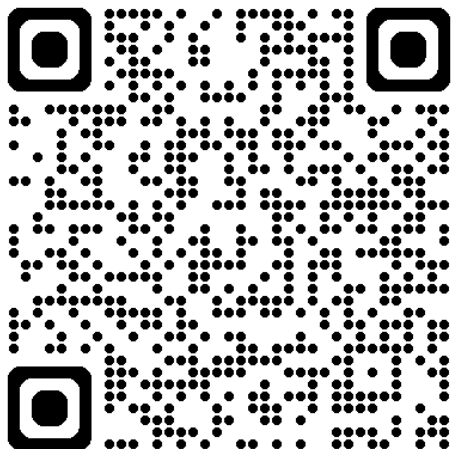

Day 1: Friday, April 21, 2028 Scottsdale, Arizona Explore the famous canyons of the American West on a journey featuring 3 national parks. Start your journey in Scottsdale and join your fellow travelers for a welcome dinner. (D)

Day 2: Saturday, April 22, 2028 Scottsdale - Sedona - Grand Canyon Start your day in Sedona, where the sun shines on stunning sandstone formations. Soak in the inviting atmosphere and colorful vistas while browsing the many arts-and-crafts shops. Make your way through Kaibab National Forest before reaching the South Rim of the Grand Canyon. This evening, enjoy dinner on your own and time to explore Grand Canyon National Park. (B)

Day 3: Sunday, April 23, 2028 Grand Canyon Area - Lake Powell Follow the winding landscape along East Rim Drive, bringing you to Cameron Trading Post. For nearly a century, the post has acted as a haven for travelers, traders, and explorers. Continue north through the mesa-studded desert before arriving at your home for the next 2 evenings, overlooking the stunning blue waters of Lake Powell. This evening, we journey into the town of Page for an authentic Navajo meal and show. (B, D)

Day 4: Monday, April 24, 2028 Lake Powell This morning, embark on a guided scenic rafting adventure to iconic Horseshoe Bend and experience the peaceful grandeur of the Colorado River. As you glide between towering canyon walls, you'll witness one of the Southwest's most awe-inspiring landscapes from a perspective few ever get to see. This afternoon, it's your choice. Enjoy a relaxing lunch at the resort and continue exploring the region's stunning waterways on a scenic Lake Powell cruise - OR - join a guided excursion through the breathtaking passages of Antelope Canyon. This evening, take time to enjoy Lake Powell Resort on your own. (B)

Day 5: Tuesday, April 25, 2028 Lake Powell - Bryce Canyon National Park - Springdale, Utah (Zion) Your journey continues at Bryce Canyon National Park, famous for its ethereal spires known as *hoodoos*. These rock formations, created over thousands of years by wind and water, display natural orange and red hues that contrast with the deep green forests of the park. Take in the wide vistas as you wander along Sunset Point, leading into Sunrise Point Rim Trail. Your day ends in Springdale, gateway to Zion National Park. (B)

Day 6: Wednesday, April 26, 2028 Zion National Park In sheer magnitude and color, few places on earth match the beauty of Zion National Park. Marvel at red and white sandstone cliffs as you take a full day to explore Utah's first national park. Climb aboard Zion's open-air tram and wind your way alongside Virgin River and through the 2400-foot deep, half-mile wide Zion Canyon. This afternoon, continue to enjoy time in the great outdoors exploring the park independently. (B)

Day 7: Thursday, April 27, 2028 Springdale - Las Vegas, Nevada Trade nature's beauty for the lights of the Vegas strip. This 4-mile stretch of road features neon-lit resorts and around-the-clock action. This afternoon, toast to the end of your journey at a farewell lunch with your fellow travelers. Make the most of your free time this evening to experience the best that Vegas has to offer. (B, L)

Day 8: Friday, April 28, 2028 Las Vegas Enjoy a day of leisure.

The overall activity level of this tour is a level 2. This means you like a balanced approach to travel. Walking two to three miles over the course of a day is no problem for you. You can handle a variety of terrains, from cobblestone streets to moderate hills with relative ease and without assistance. You can climb two flights of stairs with ease. Expect some full days balanced with free time to recharge or set out on your own adventure. You can handle altitudes up to 6,000 feet. While this level is appropriate for travelers that require mobility assistance devices, there could be times when you may have to sit out on some of the included activities.

Travel with an average of 37 people (maximum of 44).

If you require any special assistance while on tour, please make us aware at the time of reservation so the necessary request form can be sent to your attention.

Your tour includes several early-morning departures. You should expect to depart your hotel between 7:00-8:00 a.m. most days to ensure you are able to experience all that is included on this tour.

Personal audio devices (headsets) are not included on this tour.

Single accommodations are limited and are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Single rate subject to change based on availability.

Our transfers will depart from Phoenix airport for Scottsdale.

To complete your tour, we include round-trip airport-to-hotel transfers when purchasing our airfare with your tour. If you have arranged for your own air, we are pleased to provide you the option of purchasing these transfers. Please note that all transfers will leave at pre-scheduled times.

Our air travelers will arrive into Phoenix, Arizona airport.

For air-inclusive reservations, the name provided at time of booking must match your government-issued ID that will be used during travel. Name changes are subject to penalties.

Please be advised, many airlines do not provide advance seat assignments until check-in at the airport. Advance seating will be subject to the airline's terms and conditions.

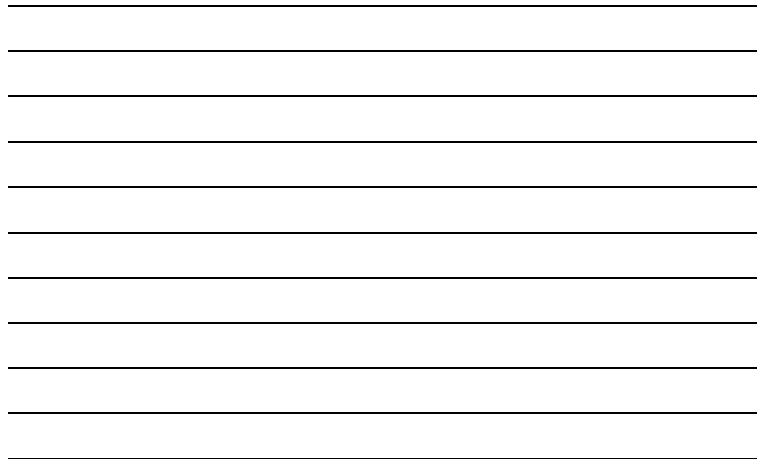
